

## TTEF CONSULTATION & PLANNING SUB-COMMITTEE NOTES

MEETING; Thursday, 23<sup>rd</sup> Aug at 2.30pm at NDYC. WELCOME & APOLOGIES; Present were; CH, JB, IC & TP

1. NOTES FROM MEETING of Friday 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2019 were accepted as a true record.

2. MATTERS ARISING FROM THAT MEETING;

a) Northam Burrows; Dunes were still eroding but not in the tip area. The Golf Club application was still under consideration.

b) Houseboats & liveaboards; TP was to chase Capt. Laboustir and CH would find the minutes of the Harbour Board.

c) Website; no progress has been made.

d) Yelland; especially ashbed “trails”; DCC Report has been produced. The site is designated a “conservation area” by them but no enforcement has taken place. JB was writing to Mr. Caddy to get the “No Cycling” sign replaced on the gate. FPC are being asked to write to Mr Bowman about the report. CH was replying to Ms Raffell.

e) Seven Brethren Bank; JB has objected to aspects of the pre-application.

f) Housing at Pitt Lane CH said there was nothing currently to report

g) Richmond Dock; TP would contact Val Deering re a possible speaker for the next main meeting.

h) Brunswick Wharf; Cllr Busby has suggested that the tender process be restarted.

i) Barton Lane. This item should now be removed from the agenda.

k) Letters of appreciation; TP has written to retiring reps and received a response from Brad Bunyard.

l) Bird disturbance; the report has now been issued with dog walking the main problem. An umbrella organisation was needed and the Biosphere seemed an obvious one. Signage & interpretation were best with specific signs for specific areas. Justification was needed on signs. Specific publications (pamphlets etc) should be targeted at activities and suggested walking routes given. Social & local media.

Protected areas, present & new were needed with Chivenor a case in point.

On site staff would be of huge benefit and ongoing work was needed.

m) Reptile fences. CH reported that 7 checks should be made but these could be in just one week!
