

TTEF CONSULTATION & PLANNING SUB-COMMITTEE NOTES

MEETING; Friday 17th May 2019 at 2.30pm at NDYC. WELCOME & APOLOGIES;
Present were CH, JB & TP

1. NOTES FROM MEETING of Friday, 5th April, 2019, were accepted as a true record.

2. MATTERS ARISING FROM THAT MEETING;

a) Northam Burrows;

b) Houseboats & liveaboards; as there was no progress, TP was asked to contact Harbour Master.

c) Website; not much progress has been made.

d) Yelland; JB reports that leaflets have been distributed both in Yelland and in Braunton appealing for objections to the power station development. Aim to get councils to purchase and return to marsh and flood plain. It was noted that the land was being raised before planning permission has been granted. JB was contacting NDC for enforcement. TP to write also.

e) Oil Jetty; turbine top still there.

f) Housing at Pitt Lane CH had nothing further to report.

g) Richmond Dock; ARA were raising support for the dock to become a Community Asset. TP has written in support.

h) Brunswick Wharf; some legal problem has arisen apparently.

i) Fairview; this application has been refused.

j) Love Braunton” Dave Jenkins has signed up as their rep.

k) Democratic Correspondent; no progress made JB to follow up.

l) Bird disturbance; the report was awaited. TTEF would then follow up on what action the commissioners were taking.

m) Crone’s Turbines; the Crown Estates have not delineated any new areas in the Bristol Channel.

n) Any other matters; there were none.

i) Barton Lane (Crossways) was now for 5 “houses” not as originally in the outline application.

ii) The “Pony Field” was still under outline.
